Dr Fábio Rafael Echer

Fábio R. Echer, PhD, is a Professor of Cotton Agronomy/Physiology at São Paulo Western University (Unoeste), in Presidente Prudente, SP – Brazil. He received his BSc in Agronomy from Mato Grosso State University, Tangará da Serra, Brazil (2006); M.Sc. in Crop Science from São Paulo Western University (Unoeste) Presidente Prudente, Brazil (2008); and PhD in Crop Science/Physiology from São Paulo State University, Botucatu, Brazil (2012) in collaboration with University of Arkansas-USA (2011-2012). He was a researcher at the Mato Grosso Cotton Institute (2012-2015), where he coordinated the cotton physiology laboratory. He is currently professor/researcher of undergraduate and graduate courses in Agronomy at UNOESTE, and coordinator of the Graduate Program in Agronomy (2021-2024) and was vice-coordinator in 2017-2020. Founder and leader of the Cotton Study Group (GEA) (2016) and member of the International Association of Cotton Researchers (ICRA) since 2016. He received the Silver Card from Presidente Prudente's City Council for his work on education and research (2019). Also, he was awarded as Outstanding Advisor in the Brazilian Cotton Congress (2019). Dr. Echer has authored/co-authored over 43 refereed journal articles and has mentored 8 graduate students and 20 scientific initiation students besides 8 graduate and 10 undergraduates in progress.
