Dr Tilak Raj Sharma is Deputy Director General (Crop Science), ICAR, New Delhi. He has worked at the State Agricultural University, Palampur (1991-99), ICAR-IARI, New Delhi (1999-2017), the Department of Biotechnology (2017-2020), and ICAR (2020-present). He obtained three post Doctorate degrees: Plant Molecular Biology and Genome Analysis at the University of Alberta, Edmonton, Canada; and two from Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory, New York, USA. Dr Sharma is the fellow of the Indian National Science Academy, Indian Academy of Sciences, National Academy of Sciences, and National Academy of Agricultural Sciences. He has twice been awarded the JC Bose Fellowship of the Department of Science and Technology. For his research, Dr Sharma has been awarded the University Gold Medal and Certificate of Honour; Young Scientist Award, NAAS; ICAR Young Scientist Award, 1999; Prof Umakant Sinha Memorial Award in Biochemistry, Biophysics and Biotechnology, Indian Science Congress Association, 2001; the International World Technology Award for Biotechnology in 2003; the DBT National Bioscience Award for Career Development, 2007; NAAS Recognition Award, 2008; VASVIK Award 2011; Rafi Ahmed Kidwai Award-ICAR, 2011; NASI-Reliance Industries Platinum Jubilee Award, 2013; J C Bose National Fellowship, 2013 and 2018; Prof MGK Menon Lecture Award 2017; Prof Bishan Singh Samundari Memorial lecture award in 2017-18; and Prof KS Bilgrami Memorial Medal 2018.
