Anil Jauhri is former CEO of the National Accreditation Board for Certification Bodies (NABCB) and has 43 years of experience in the fields of quality, standards, certification, accreditation, and technical regulations. He has led the development of multiple voluntary conformity assessment schemes across multiple sectors — from yoga professionals to medical devices to good agricultural practices to food safety to private security agencies to traditional medicines — and supported a number of regulators in developing systems for use of third-party inspection/certification in sectors such as food, oil and gas, and medical devices. He is currently associated with a number of organisations: Member of the CDM Accreditation Panel of UNFCCC since 2007; Member of the Yoga Certification Board, Naturopathy Registration Board and Ayurveda Training Accreditation Board set up by the Ministry of AYUSH; Member of the Accreditation/Approval Committee of ASI GmbH, Bonn, and ASI North America; Evaluator for ISEAL Alliance for sustainability standards and certification schemes; Chairman, Steering Committee, Good Clinical Practices Professional Certification Scheme, CDSA_THSTI; Co-chair, Steering Committee for voluntary certifications in biomedical sector, AMTZ. Mr Jauhri is a nationally and internationally recognised expert having worked with such international bodies as UNFCCC, UNIDO, PTB, FAO, APO, and IFC, and was invited as an expert by WTO in 2013 and 2015.
