**Mr Marc Giband**

Marc Giband holds a degree in Plant Biology from the University of Paris, Orsay, France. He holds an MSc degree in Cellular and Molecular Biology and a PhD in Plant Molecular Biology (1987), both from the University of Strasbourg, France. Mr Giband was a post-doctoral research associate at the University of Ottawa, Canada (1987-1990), and took up a position of Research Associate at the same university (1990-1994). He is a research scientist at CIRAD (the Centre for International Cooperation in Agronomic Research for Development), based in Montpellier, France.

He worked for 13 years in Brazil with Embrapa's Cotton Research Center (Campina Grande, 2005-2010; Goiânia, 2010-2018), and currently works in cooperation with cotton improvement programs in Africa (Cameroon, Benin, and Côte d'Ivoire). His areas of expertise include cotton breeding and molecular genetics, and he presently is working mainly in pre-breeding and breeding. He currently serves as CIRAD's Cotton Supply Chain Correspondent.
