














Need for Upgrading Cotton R&D Throughout The Region

- Develop Simple, Science-Based Control Methods
- Use Indigenous Pest Control Knowledge/Methods
- Organize Farming Communities to Carry Out Control Methods

Parts of a Management Program

- Use Short-Season Varieties
- Observe Uniform Dates of Planting
- Constant Monitoring
- Removal/Destruction of Fallen Squares
- Careful Application of Insecticides on Need-Basis
- Thorough and Complete Stalk Destruction
