
Cotton in Greece

- 79,4% of total European cotton production.
- 9% of Greek's final agricultural output.
- Around 250.000 tons per year
- 100% machine picked
- Contamination free and non GMO
- The prevailing cotton status as well as the subsidies are the main factors that favored the expansion of cotton cultivation.


→Important cash crop for farmers and an economically valuable part of the total national economy.



Drastic increase of Greek cotton exports after 1990








4 main cotton cultivating areas:
