
# Changes in Supply and Demand Estimates from the February 2021 Report (Producing Countries)

2020/21

World production: 327,540 tonnes (- 3,700 tonnes) United States 16,480 tonnes (-3,700 tonnes)


The global supply of extra-fine cotton continues to decrease with estimates this month revised down to 327,000 tonnes for the 2020/21 season, a third consecutive year of decline. Over the past two decades, extra-fine production has more than halved, under pressure from low prices and high production costs. Improvements in medium staple cotton qualities and spinning technology continue to put pressure on the niche extra-fine sector. The United States remains the leading global producer with 116,000 tonnes. China, where production was as high as 200,000 tonnes in 2016, is expected to have production reach only 24,000 tonnes this season. Extra-fine cotton in China is grown mainly in the Xinjiang region, where farmers have continued to move to upland cotton. Extra-fine cotton is largely hand-picked to maintain fibre integrity. Harvest mechanisation continues to increase in the Xinijang region. Global exports are expected to recover with an increase in demand in 2020/21 following the economic shut down last season. Demand for luxury products fell more sharply and have recovered more slowly from the pandemic induced shutdown. Global exports are expected to be led by the United States with 169,000 tonnes with exports largely destined for China. Under the US-China Phase One agreement, China has agreed to import large value quantities of US agricultural products opening the Chinese market for US Pima cotton. As demand recovers and production falls, prices for extra-fine have increased to the highest level in over six years.
