
Cotton as a Commodity











India Has the Most Area Under Cotton












Imports Led by East Asia and South Asia










Exports Led by the United States








Cotton by the Numbers

- 350 million employed in the sector




Growth in Global Cotton Trade for 2019/20


Growth in Global Cotton Trade for 2019/20






Growth in Global Cotton Trade for 2019/20








Share of Global Exports in 2019/20







